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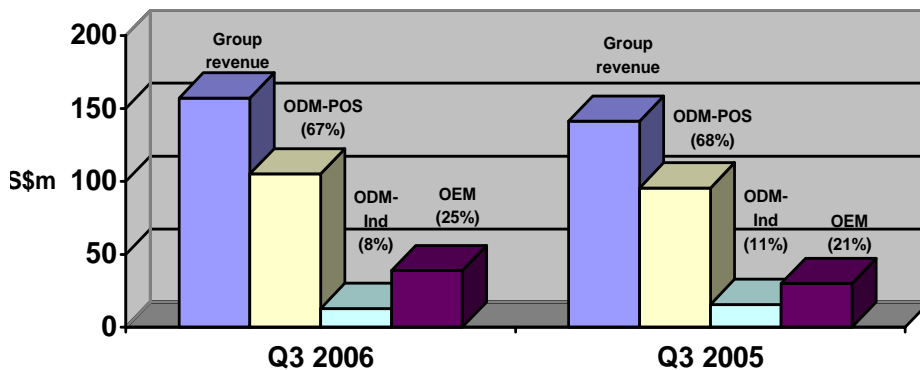
GES REPORTS 35% GROWTH FOR 3RD QUARTER PROFITS

- Group revenue for Q3 2006 grew 11% to \$157.1m
- Profit after tax for Q3 2006 increased 35% to \$13.1m
- ODM-POS turnover grew 10% to \$105.2m
- OEM segment increased 29% to \$38.9m

Singapore, 26 April 2006 – Mainboard-listed GES International Limited (“GES” or the “Group”), a leading Original Designer and Manufacturer (“ODM”) of Point-of-Sales (“POS”) systems in the world, today reported a profit after tax of \$13.1m for the 3rd quarter of the financial year ending 30 June 2006, a 35% increase from the \$9.7m reported for the previous corresponding period.

Group revenue for the three months ended 31 March 2006 increased 11% to \$157.1m, compared to \$141.3m achieved in the 3rd quarter of the last financial year.

Key Performance Highlights for Q3 2006



For the 3rd financial quarter, turnover in the ODM-POS segment increased 10% from the previous corresponding period. As the main engine of growth, the Group’s ODM-POS segment now contributes 67% to the Group’s revenue. While the Group continues to register growth for most of its ODM-Industrial Products, the Group recorded a 17.5% decline in its revenue, to \$13.0m, for this segment due to the business slowdown of a customer. The ODM-Industrial Product segment now contributes 8% to the Group’s revenue.

Besides delivering growth in the ODM segment, the Group's OEM segment has also registered growth, with revenue for the 3rd financial quarter rising 29% to \$38.9m. The OEM segment contributed 25% to the Group's revenue in the 3rd financial quarter.

Commenting on the Group's revenue growth, Mr Daniel Yeong, Chief Executive Officer and Group Managing Director of GES International Limited, said: "As we continue to operate in a highly competitive environment, we are consistently monitoring industry trends and customers' needs to develop new strategies to differentiate ourselves from the competition. Our ability to diversify our product range to provide a total solution to our customers' changing needs has helped us retain and expand our customer base, which, in turn, has enabled GES to sustain profitability."

For the nine months ended 31 March 2006, the Group's revenue increased 9% to \$497.6m from the \$456.9m reported in the previous corresponding period. The Group's profit after tax for the same period grew 28% to \$39.8m.

On the Board's outlook on GES' performance, Mr Yeong commented: "Based on current demand levels from our customers, we expect the positive momentum in our business to continue into the 4th quarter. With our capabilities and expertise, GES is poised for further growth in the challenging market."
