**Frontline To Build Virtual Integrated Library Information System In Brunei Darussalam**

**Singapore, 5 February 2007** – Frontline Technologies Corporation Limited (“Frontline”), a leading IT Services Provider in Asia, announced today that its wholly-owned subsidiary, Frontline Solutions Pte Ltd (“Frontline Solutions”) has inked a deal with Brunei Darussalam’s Ministry of Education (“MOE”) to build a Virtual Integrated Library Information System (VILIS).

Working with local prime contractor, Alif Technologies Sdn Bhd (“Alif Technologies”), Frontline Solutions is one of the sub-contractors selected to develop and implement the BND \$11 million VILIS for Brunei’s Ministry of Education. This project is expected to take 8 months starting from February 2007.

Frontline Solution had an earlier successful partnership with Alif Technologies to develop an eLibrary Portal for the Universiti of Brunei Darussalam in March 2005. The eLibrary Portal is a multilingual (English, Arabic and Bahasa Melayu) integrated service portal to serve the university’s library community. This Portal was the first successfully launched eService project by the Brunei Government as part of its 10-year IT Master Plan.

For the VILIS Portal, it was initiated by the MOE with the aim of meeting the needs of education and teaching professionals throughout Brunei for information and library services by providing convenient, timely access to relevant literature and reference guides. As such, Frontline Solutions will create a nation-wide framework for VILIS to link educational officers and practitioners in both urban and rural regions to an integrated, consolidated educational information, knowledge and library network.

The VILIS Portal will be built by leveraging on Frontline Solutions' proprietary Educational Framework, which was used for the Nanyang Technological University (NTU) in Singapore since 2003. Using the NTU education portal as a working model, Frontline Solutions is able to build VILIS using the same foundation and concepts, thereby ensuring a faster time to market and quality delivery for VILIS.

Mr Steve Ting, Executive Chairman of Frontline Technologies said, "We are privileged to be involved in Brunei Darussalam's eService project development. With our past successes in building similar projects of such complexity in the past, we can capitalise on our expertise to develop VILIS to achieve greater quality and time efficiencies".
